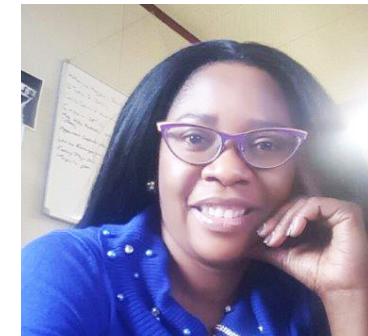
Why we think Jo Rispoli's best for GSAC Chair!
